Students look for the caches the Spanish teachers have hidden around our town. - Dinner with the families.
Monday 24th APRIL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 9:00 Welcome event with our headmistress and local authorities. - 10:00 Andalusian breakfast at school. - 10:30 Tour around our school guided by the Erasmus + team students. - 11:00 Lecture: “Geocaching and tourism - how to create a cache based on tourism”. - 12:00 Workshop: Let’s produce our own cache on tourism. - 14:00 Lunch break – students go home for lunch. - 17:00 Sightseeing in Loja – organized by the Tourist office in town. - 19:00 Students come back home for dinner.
Tuesday 25th APRIL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 8:30 Departure to visit the beautiful city of Granada. - 9:30 Virtual Geocaching in Granada city centre and later in the Alhambra. - 14:00 Free time to have lunch and rest. - 16:00 We’ll go up to the gorgeous Muslim palace - “the Alhambra”. Students and teacher will have the opportunity to visit the palaces accompanied by Moraima art teachers who will tell us the most relevant information about the monument. - 20:00 Time to come back to Loja for dinner and rest with the host families.

Registration of the caches found in the morning. Evaluation of the geocaching activity carried out in Loja. Why is geocaching a motivating activity to be included in school programs?
